BEFORE THE GAME:

All fans of Kilmarnock are welcome in the entire city centre of Bruges. There are plenty of things to see and a lot of pubs and restaurants. Most of the times the fans of the visiting team gather in the “**EIERMARKT**” area. That is a little square near the Market place, all with pubs. We would recommend the fans go somewhere in that area to gather before the game, but of course they can stay elsewhere in the city if they like.



Fans also not to go around the stadium area prior to the game as that is the area for the home fans. If they are seen in the pubs around the stadium they will be asked to leave and go to the city centre, which is the designated area for the away fans.

GETTING TO THE STADIUM:

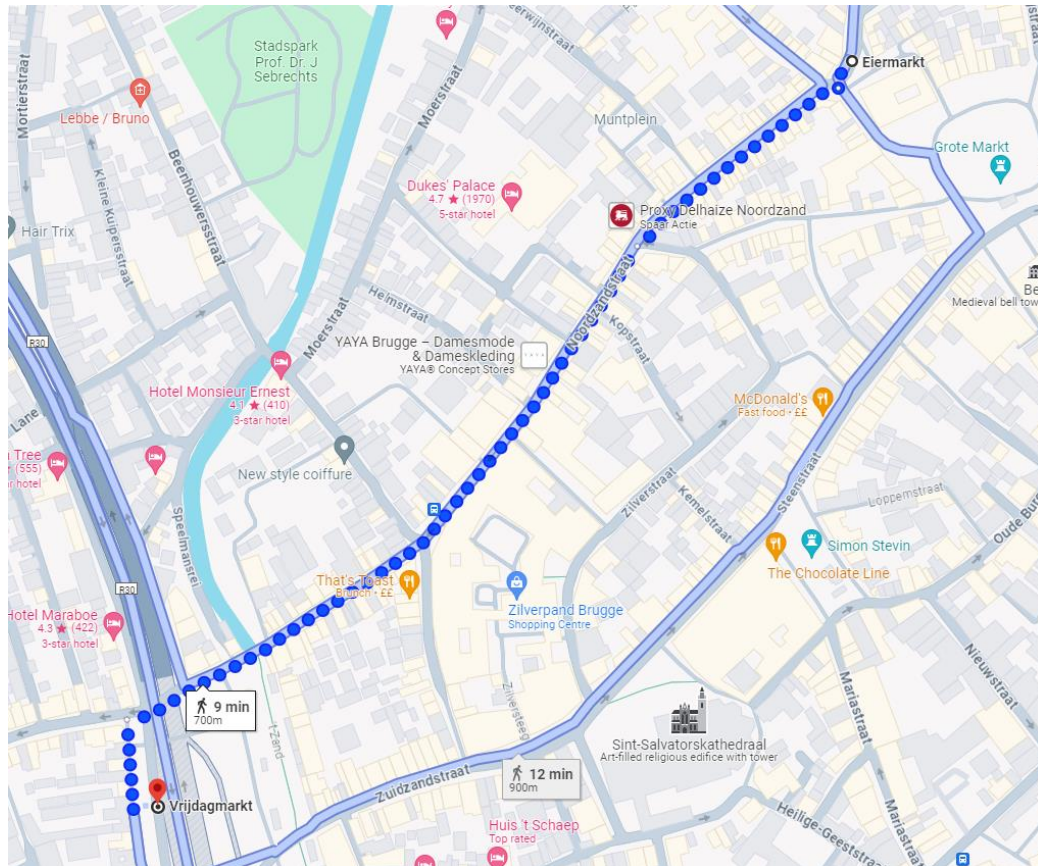
A free shuttle service from the city centre to the visitors section of the stadium with busses. These busses will operate from the square “**VRIJDAGMARKT**” and will start to ride around 17.30 hours until 19.00 hours (see map).

Shuttles will be escorted by police and the drive takes about 10 minutes. Meeting point for the shuttles (Vrijdagmarkt), will be marked with LED-boarding and is situated approx 600 metres from the Eiermarkt.

Fans who use their own transportation to come to Bruges are requested to park in the city centre and use the shuttles towards the stadium.

If the Kilmarnock supporters would like to do a short fan walk from the Eiermarkt towards the shuttle service the Belgian Police will be happy to facilitate this.

A fan walk all the way towards the stadium is not allowed while it is too far away (6 km) and also unsafe.



AFTER THE GAME:

The same shuttle buses will bring the fans back from the stadium to the city.

INFO FOR SUPPORTER BUSES:

Fans arriving in coaches and minibuses should be dropped off in the city centre (Vrijdagmarkt) and use the free shuttles to get to the stadium.

The driver of the coach/minibus will be allowed to park their empty vehicle at the visitors parking at the stadium (Doornstraat). **NO PRIVATE CARS ALLOWED AT STADIUM**

After the game fans can go back with their coach/minibus that will be waiting for them at the stadium exit.
