Job Title: Stadium Facilities Operative (Part-Time)
Reporting to: Stadium Manager
Working Hours: 25-hours per week

We are seeking a dependable and hardworking Stadium Facilities Operative whose primary responsibility will be the internal cleaning of stadium facilities. This includes offices, hospitality suites, corridors, reception areas, internal concourses, toilets, changing rooms, and community spaces.

The role requires a minimum of 25 hours per week with flexible scheduling. Typical working patterns fall within early morning shifts (05:00–09:00) or evening shifts (18:00–22:00). These hours may vary depending on matchdays, events, and operational needs, making the position ideal for someone needing flexibility around other commitments.

Key Responsibilities

- Carry out internal cleaning across the stadium's facilities, ensuring all areas are maintained to a high standard.
- Prepare internal spaces for matchdays, events, and daily club operations.
- Ensure health, safety, and hygiene standards are consistently met.
- Identify and report any maintenance issues or hazards.
- Work independently or as part of a small team to complete tasks efficiently and professionally.

- Previous cleaning experience, ideally in a workplace or public building.
- Reliable, punctual, and self-motivated, with strong attention to detail.
- Comfortable working flexible or anti-social hours, including early mornings, evenings, or weekends.
